
“Oversight and Governance”

The Board of Commissioners serves as the governing body of the Housing Authority and is responsible for establishing policy, providing oversight, and ensuring compliance with U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requirements and applicable state and federal laws. The Board’s core responsibilities include appointing and evaluating the Executive Director; approving the Agency’s annual budget and strategic direction; adopting policies that ensure sound financial management, internal controls, and ethical operations; ensuring housing programs are administered fairly, efficiently, and in compliance with HUD regulations; reviewing operational and financial performance through regular meetings and reports; and ensuring the completion of timely annual independent audits and proper procurement and personnel practices.
